Recommended to also satisfy US: Difference, Inequality, Agency. If chosen wisely, Cultural Literacy courses can be double-counted in the Arts and Letters, Science, or Social Science Areas of Inquiry.

62 upper-division credits are required for the Bachelor's degree. To meet these general credit requirements, 18-21 credits of Core Education or elective courses will need to be taken at the 300 or 400 level. For other options, see advisor.

*To earn 180 total credits required for the Bachelor's degree, students will need to earn additional college credit as specified. This may take the form of a second major, a minor or general elective credits. Some of these may be upper-division, as students must also ensure they have earned 62 upper-division credits prior to graduating.
