III. Specific Major Requirements

Checkpoint for Major Continuation:

Successful completion of two-year music core with grades of C- or better; successful completion of Composition I series (MUS 240, 241, 242) with grades of B- or better. Students may retake only one in the nine-quarter Composition course sequence (Composition I, II & III) in which they earn a C+ or lower.

Performance Studies:

Students must take six consecutive terms of MUP 165 on piano only, with exceptions allowed by proficiency examination administered by Composition faculty.

Ensembles: Nine terms of an approved large ensemble are required. For approved ensembles, check the <u>UO Catalog</u> section "Ensemble Requirements for Music Majors." Up to three terms of Gamelan Ensemble may count toward the large ensemble requirement.
